## **Reflection: "The Spirit of Truth will lead you to complete truth" – John 16:12-15**

On Sunday we celebrated the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. The Holy Trinity is the deepest mystery at the heart of our Christian Faith. God is beyond our understanding and, however hard we try to use our limited, human language to explain the Trinity, we are left with something quite unsatisfactory. But whilst God is beyond our grasp, He desires to share Himself with us and to be known. So, what really matters is that we understand that God is love. Indeed, He is a relationship of love. St Augustine described the Trinity like this: The Father is the lover, Jesus the beloved and the Holy Spirit is the love shared between them. The best news is that He invites each one of us into that relationship of love. He holds nothing back from us - in the same way as Jesus is in the Father and the Father in Jesus, Jesus is in us and we are in Jesus through the Holy Spirit living within us. Whilst we will not ever understand the full beauty and wonder of this on earth, we can be assured that the Holy Spirit will one day lead us to the complete truth.

**Loving God, help us to know You as you want to be known as Father, Son and Holy Spirit so that we can be drawn ever more fully into that eternal relationship of Love. Amen**
