Dear Parents/Carers

Reflection: “He said the blessing over them; then broke them and gave them to his disciples” – Luke 9:11-17

As we celebrate our School Feast, we reflect on how wonderful it is that Jesus gives Himself to us in such a humble form, that we can see and touch and even eat. He calls us His body, uniting and associating Himself with us even though we make mistakes time and time again. Our Gospel this week is one of Jesus' most famous miracles: the feeding of the 5000. It is a prefiguration of what Jesus will do with bread and wine at the last supper – bless it, break it and give it – with miraculous results. This time the miracle is that the food is multiplied and thousands of people are physically fed so that they can stay and listen to Him and receive the healing they need. At the Last Supper, and today when the priest says the prayers of consecration, the miracle is that Jesus gives us Himself to feed us spiritually. We too can stay with Him, listen and receive healing or whatever else we need to live as members of His body.

Jesus, You are the Bread of Life. May we receive that life from You by accepting the gift of Yourself that You give us in the Eucharist. Unite us with You and each other as One body. Amen

Eleven Year 9 pupils were lucky enough to attend the presentation of the prestigious Lancashire Book of the Year Meet the Author event at UCLan last Friday. They listened to four of the shortlisted authors in person who discussed the inspirations for their books and gave plenty of useful creative writing tips.
